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What Should I Bring to My Appointment?

Basic Information

- Social Security Cards (or ITIN) for anyone on the return, including children, spouse, and other dependents.
- Valid Photo ID
- Savings and Checking Routing and Account Numbers for Direct Deposit of Refunds



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Tax Forms

- Copy of 2008 Return, if available
- W-2 forms from all 2009 jobs
- 1099-G (unemployment)
- 1099-INT (bank interest)

- 1099-MISC (miscellaneous)
- W-2G (gambling winnings)
- 1098 (dividend or interest)
- Information about your educational expenses including student loan interest paid, tuition paid, and other student fees
- Childcare expenses paid and the provider's name, address, and SSN or Tax ID number
- If you own your own home, bring documentation of mortgage interest, property taxes, charitable contributions, and medical expenses
- Bring any other tax mailings you've received

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
