

What is a Leader on Loan?

A Leader on Loan is an employee you loan to United Way in order to help with the community fundraising campaign. A Leader on Loan is released from regular job duties to work 12 to 16 hours a month between June and November.

A Leader on Loan will be asked to attend two workdays per month. Each workday will begin with a brief meeting to discuss projects. LoLs will schedule meetings and make calls on assigned companies during the afternoon.
