## ADVOCACY

Our priorities focus on the needs of our community to boost economic productivity, enhance self-sufficiency, and promote healthy families in North Texas.

## COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT

We research, collate, and publish full reports every few years to determine Denton County's highest-priority needs. Annual updates assess changing trends.

## COMMUNITY RESOURCES

We help people in crisis through a local helpline, online database, and local resource directories to connect those in need with service providers in Denton County.

This 24/7 digital platform provides self-care resources to help you nurture your mental and emotional wellbeing.

## DENTON COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH LEADERSHIP TEAM

## DENTON COUNTY HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS LEADERSHIP TEAM

This Team fosters an effective and coordinated system of homelessness prevention and intervention to make homelessness rare, brief, and nonrecurring.

## DENTON COUNTY WORKFORCE SUCCESS LEADERSHIP TEAM

This Team works to increase financial capabilities and earning potential for working families in Denton County to move them from survival to stability.

## DENTON COUNTY WORKS

We collate resources to bridge the gap between job seekers and employers with local job listings, useful tips, and workforce guidance.

## FREE TAX PREPARATION

We train community volunteers to provide free tax preparation across Denton County to seniors and low to moderately low-income families.

## HOMELESSNESS POINT IN TIME COUNT

The annual census of people experiencing homelessness by trained volunteers that provides a snapshot of the homeless experience on any given day.

## LANDLORD ENGAGEMENT

We centralize communication between landlords and housing service agencies to increase access to safe and affordable housing for Denton County households in crisis.

## PARTNER AGENCIES & NETWORK OF NONPROFITS

We amplify the efforts of highly efficient and effective nonprofits by investing resources through grants and holistic support to address the most critical needs of Denton County.

## VETERAN FINANCIAL STABILITY PROGRAM

We support eligible Veterans, their surviving spouses, and dependents in crisis with rental and utility assistance, transportation, and dental emergencies.

## WORKFORCE UPSKILLING

We coordinate quarterly skills training for resume writing, interview practice, and building the soft skills necessary for Denton County residents to get hired.
