**STEP 1:** Go shopping for a backpack suitable for both boys and girls!

**STEP 2:** Fill the backpack with the following items (and more) for Pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

- 1 Plastic pencil box
- 1 Pack of latex-free #2 pencils (12-ct)
- 1 Pack of crayons (24-ct)
- 1 Pencil sharpener w/ receptacle
- 1 Pack of latex-free pink erasers (2-ct)
- 1 Bottle of glue (4-oz)
- 4 Glue sticks
- 1 Pair of scissors, blunt
- 1 Pack of 12" x 18" construction paper, assorted colors
- 1 Pack of 12" x 18" manila paper
- 2 Packs of wide-ruled filler notebook paper (100-ct)
- 4 Composition notebooks, wide-ruled
- 4 Folders w/ brads and pockets, assorted colors
- 1 3-hole pencil pouch
- 1 Pack of colored pencils, pre-sharpened
- 1 Pack of thick markers (12-ct)
- 1 Pack of multi-colored highlighters (4-ct)
- 1 Ruler (flexible) w/both standard and metric markings
- 3 70-ct spiral notebooks, wide ruled
