

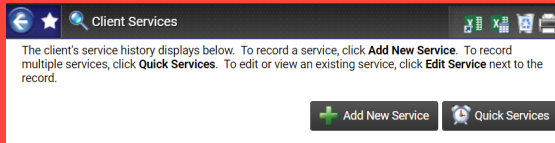
THE IMPORTANCE AND PROCESS BEHIND

RECORDING UNMET NEEDS FOR CLIENTS

An unmet need is a need that the client has but that can not be met by the community currently. The reason the need is not met could be: funds are unavailable for the resource, the resource does not exist in the community or the client does not meet program requirements for programs that do exist.

HOW TO RECORD UNMET NEEDS

Go to the client's dashboard. On your side menu, navigate to the Enrollment and Services menu and then Services submenu. Select the Add New Service Button on the next screen.



Record each unmet need the client currently has.
