OUR COLLABORATIVE INITIATIVES & PROGRAMS



We research, collate, and publish full reports every few years to determine Denton County's highest-priority needs. Annual updates assess changing trends.



We collate and analyze Coordinated Entry data from a countywide network of shelters and service providers, as well as the annual one-day homeless population census, to better understand the nature of homelessness.

The annual census of people experiencing homelessness by trained volunteers that provides a snapshot of the homeless experience on any given day.

We centralize communication between landlords and housing service agencies to increase access to safe and affordable housing for Denton County households in crisis.


